SUGGESTED VIDEO	AUDIO
Opening Slate (like last week)	(Some type of intro music)
1. Scene of a chess board with a player hand on a piece about to move it. Second scene of a person with a puzzling look on their face as if they are in deep contemplation.	NARRATOR (voiceover): Figuring out the next move can be difficult. Knowing what to do next can be quite challenging. Deciding which step to take next can be a critical. The scripture says how can you understand what to do next unless someone guides you? Get ready for an amazing step by step voyage into an understanding of the journey of faith. Discovery what to do next!
2. Footage of people coming down on Sunday to be prayed for. Then maybe someone is standing in the kitchen or bathroom looking at their bottles of pills, contemplating whether or not to take them.	NARRATOR (voiceover): After I have been prayed for and I make my faith confession what do I do next? Do I still go to the doctor? Do I take the medicine? Do I follow the doctor's order?
3. Person sitting with the classified ads from the newspaper circling different jobs with a big marker.	NARRATOR (voiceover): After I have prayed for employment and I am confessing my new job what should I do next? Should I sit by the phone and wait for God to have someone call me? Do I go out looking for a job hoping someone will hire me? Do I take the first job that comes along or wait for the perfect job I prayed for?
4. A woman sitting looking through a wedding magazine. (must show cover and/or inside pictures of wedding dresses).	NARRATOR (voiceover): After I have asked God to send me a mate and I am confessing that I am a virtuous woman and God is causing me to have favor in the sight of my husband to be what else should I do? Should I begin to dress sexy to attract attention? Should I go back to the

nightclubs to find a mate? Should I expect the next man to smile at me to be the one? Should I ask a friend to fix me up with someone? What should I do?

5. Show person from last time looking at bills and calculating them in frustration. Maybe even the same person on the phone yelling at a bill collector in exasperation.

NARRATOR (voiceover): After I have asked God to help me with my bills and I am confessing by faith that all my needs are met, what do I do next? Should I just write a check for the bill and hope God puts the money in the bank? What should I do? Do I call my creditors and tell a lie and ask for more time? Do I just not answer the phone until the collectors get tired of calling?

6. Shot of couple from Spiritual Encounter arguing.

NARRATOR (voiceover): After I have prayed for my marriage and I still see no change what should I do? I keep saying that my mate loves me like Jesus loves the church, but what should I do? Should I just leave and hope that he comes to his senses? Should I give him the cold treatment, not speak to him to show him he needs to change? Should I anoint the bed with oil and put prayer cloths under the pillows?

7. Quick run-through of all previous scenes then show one good shot of Pastor teaching.
